



Clermont gold shows promise

BULK sample results for a Clermont gold project have identified significant potential for further high grade runs that have not been mined.

The runs, at Impact Minerals Limited's Blackridge conglomerate-hosted project, about 30km north of Clermont, are closer to surface and deeper, and are beyond the limited mining depths achieved by early miners.

In addition gold results from bulk samples taken by previous workers and by Impact also indicate the potential for large volumes of lower grade gold between these high grade runs.

The data demonstrates the large scale potential of the gold bearing units at Blackridge, and further bulk samples are planned for this quarter. They will mostly be taken on granted Mining Lease 2385, recently purchased by Impact Minerals and now approved by the Mines Minister.
