



Big Impact

Shares in the Andrew Forrest-backed Impact Minerals jumped after the explorer announced encouraging drilling results from its Broken Hill joint venture project. Impact reported a 1.2m thick unit of massive nickel-copper sulphide within a 4m thick zone of mineralisation about 60m from surface. It said the drill hole was 20m beneath previous high-grade intercepts at the Red Hill Mine shaft. Its shares jumped 0.3¢ to 2.7¢.
